Your submission of the images and text serves as your agreement for said images and text to be reproduced in the 2020 Byenal Sesel catalogue and/or be used in any related promotional or archival materials without remuneration of any kind. This does not affect the intellectual ownership rights of the artist.

SECTION 5: FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANTS:

Artists are strongly encouraged to seek financial support for their participation in the Byenal Sesel 2020. This can be explored through contact with their respective National Arts Councils, Culture Ministries, and Galleries or through private and corporate sponsorship.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- 1. The Byenal Sesel will open on Saturday 25th April 2020.
- 2. International participants should arrive in Seychelles on or around Saturday 18th April 2020.
- 3. International participants will receive logistical assistance from the Seychelles National Arts Council with regards to collection from the airport, transport during stay etc.
- 4. The exhibition will be installed during the period Monday 20th April 2020 to Friday 24th April 2020. The National Arts Council will facilitate equipment required for the realisation of work as well as the organisation of suitable dedicated exhibition space. Please note that the Byenal Sesel 2020 will be mainly exhibited on the main island of Mahe, however there will also be smaller expositions on the islands of Praslin and La Digue. Submission of this application confirms that the artist is prepared to exhibit on any one of the three selected islands if selected to participate.
- 5. International participants will share the venues dedicated to the Byenal with local artists. There will be opportunities for vibrant cultural and social exchange, with events organised to specifically enable networking and the sharing of ideas and practice throughout the Byenal period.

6. International participants will leave Seychelles shortly after the opening of the Byenal.

- The Byenal will close on Friday 22nd May 2020, at which time prize winners will be announced and subsequently notified.
- **8.** Work created by international participants will be shipped to them by the Seychelles National Arts Council shortly after the close of the Byenal.

SECTION 6: FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SEYCHELLOIS AND RESIDENT PARTICIPANTS:

The National Arts Council will facilitate equipment required for the realisation of work as well as the organisation of suitable dedicated exhibition space.

PLEASE NOTE: The Byenal Sesel 2020 will be mainly exhibited on the island of Mahe, however there will also be smaller expositions on the islands of Praslin and La Digue. Submission of this application confirms that the artist is prepared to exhibit on any one of the three islands if selected to participate.
