

The International Federation of Arts Councils and Culture Agencies (IFACCA) is the global network of arts councils and ministries of culture, with member institutions in over seventy (70) countries. IFACCA's vision is to create a world in which arts and culture thrive and are recognised by governments and peoples for their contribution to society.

IFACCA provides members with a trusted international forum and a gateway to arts councils and ministries of culture around the world. It also provides opportunities for members to participate and play a leadership role in IFACCA events, programmes and initiatives, provide members with access to a selection of tools to facilitate sharing of information. IFACCA also provides members with networking opportunities to promote arts and culture activities, events and publications and give members priority access to the World Summit on Arts and Culture.

The international federation also offers members the oppportunity to collaborate on regional projects and get secretariat assistance, including help coordinating programmes, brokering partnerships, liaising with international networks, and participating in major international events.

The Africa chapter meeting was previously scheduled to take place in September of 2020 in Seychelles, following restrategization the meeting took place virtually instead for two (2) days.
